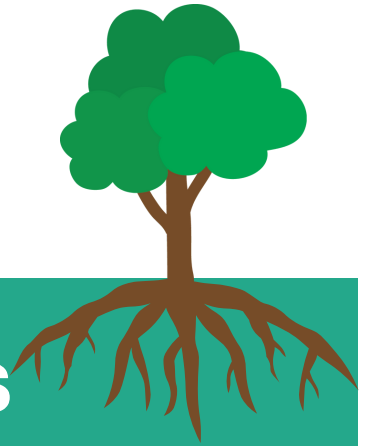
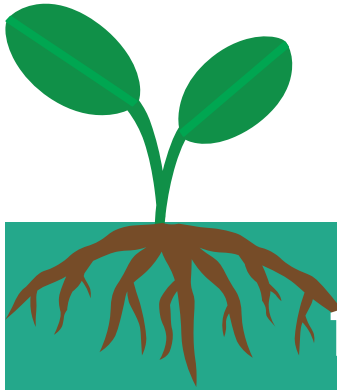

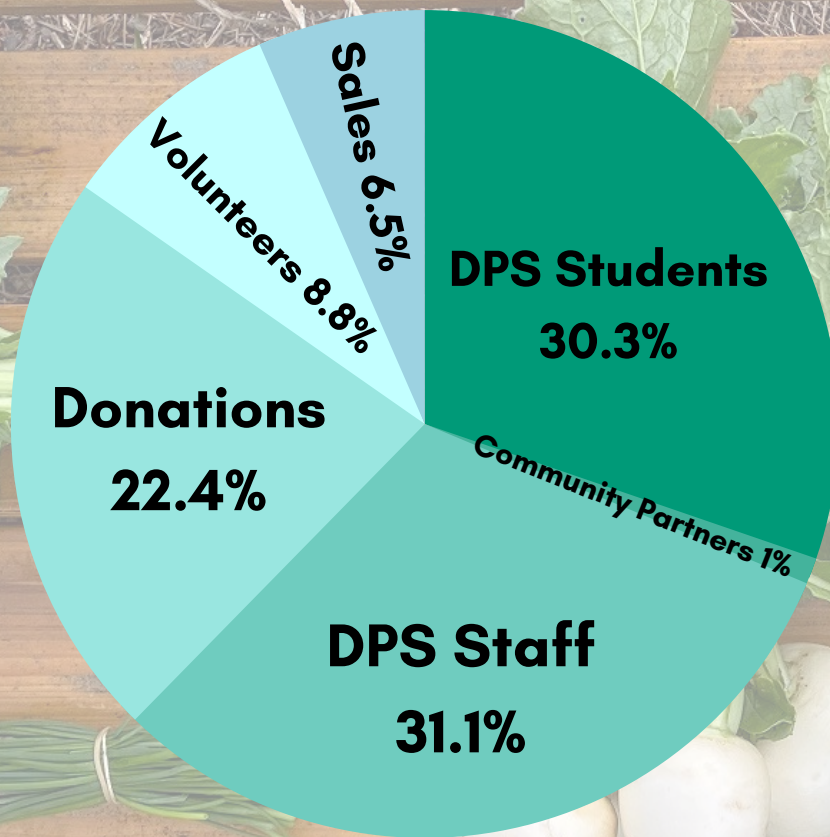

95 campers over **6** weeks

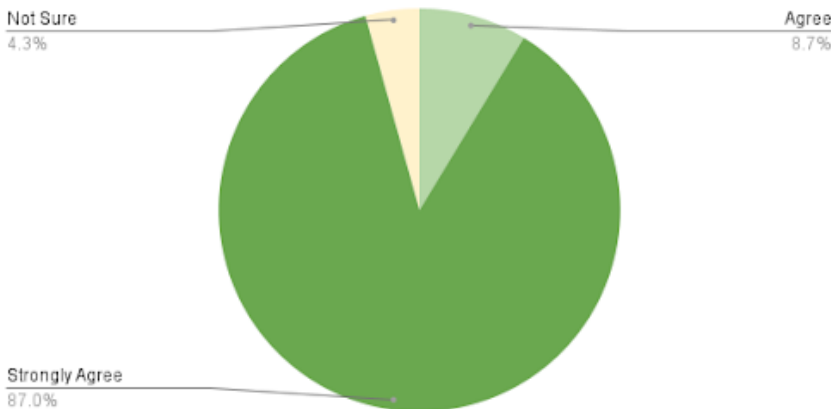
98% of campers maintained or improved reading levels

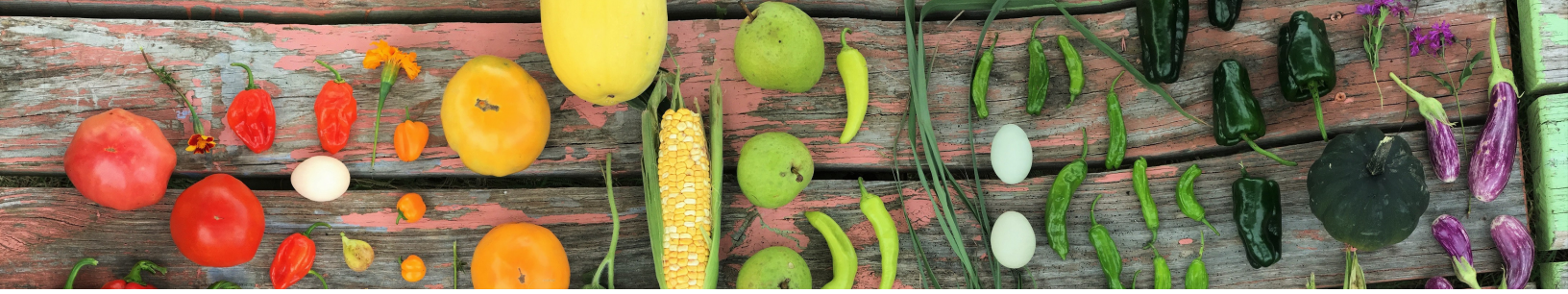
